

ORDINANCE NO. 1999-4

AN ORDINANCE WAIVING COMPETITIVE BIDDING AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY THEREFORE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF OZARK, ARKANSAS THAT:

I.

Arkansas Code Ann. §18-58-303 and City of Ozark Ordinance No. 1995-12 require competitive bidding, but allow the City Council by ordinance to waive competitive bidding in instances where it is not practical or feasible to accept bids.

II.

The City Council deems it not practical nor feasible to advertise for and accept competitive bids for the management of a \$500,000.00 U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development grant to the City of Ozark. Thus, the competitive bidding requirements are waived, and the Mayor is authorized to contract with Western Arkansas Planning and Development District, Inc. to manage said \$500,000.00 grant.

III.

It being necessary for the preservation of the public health, safety, and welfare, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage.
