

ORDINANCE NO. 2019- 14

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF OZARK, ARKANSAS, AN ORDINANCE ENTITLED:

“AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 1994-14 TO PROVIDE FOR CRIMINAL PENALTIES FOR OPERATING A BUSINESS, TRADE, OCCUPATION, VOCATION OR CALLING WITHOUT SECURING A BUSINESS LICENSE AS REQUIRED BY SUCH ORDINANCE, AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.”

Section 1. Any person required under Ordinance No. 1994-14 to secure a City license for operation of a trade, business, occupation, vocation or calling, who shall fail to do so shall be, upon being found guilty, be adjudged guilty of an unclassified misdemeanor, and may be fined not more than Fifty Dollars (\$50.00) for a first offense, and not more than \$100.00 for a second or subsequent offense. Each calendar month or part thereof, of operation in violation of such ordinance shall be deemed a separate offense.

Section 2. This ordinance being necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, the enforcement mechanism for Ord. No. 1994-14 being critical to the proper regulation of business in the City of Ozark, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage.
